Old Business

Supervisor Haughton: There is a lot of misinformation about working with the Dolgeville Police Department. The Police Chief came to the Office and spoke with Supervisor Haughton and did not clear it with the village of Dolgeville Mayor or the Board. Councilwoman Gressler put together some rough figures as to what it could potentially cost the tax payers to have the Dolgeville Police Department come into the Town of Manheim. It would be about \$10.00 per thousand if it was just the Town Wide and the Village still maintain the village. If it was that the Town takes over the entire police department it would be \$7.74 per thousand. That would be a large tax increase to the residents.

Supervisor Haughton: We need to send a letter to the Village of Dolgeville letting them know that we are not interested in having the Village Police Department at this time.

New Business

Ruth Jaikin gave the Town Board Members a copy of the Rules and Regulations that need to be updated.
